Note writing for Dentists

Its obviously important to document preop consultations and treatment sessions so here is a handy checklist for what to write.

Before sedation

Write about options given for anxiety management, e.g. IV, RA, referral to hospital for GA

Write that a sedation consent form has been given to the patient and that they have watched my consent video or you have taken them through the consent form if you prefer.

Ensure that the patient has had treatment estimate printed

During treatment

All sedation preop consultation, consent and monitoring sheets that we do will all be left in the practice for you to store against the patients notes.

We will keeping a copy of our sedation monitoring form digitally for auditing purposes, they will be anonymised.

We would suggest that you write in your own notes that IV sedation has been carried out and what the total dose of midazolam was given.
